

Project # 1 – Corryville Cleanup Day Proposal

A- What do you want to accomplish?

In association with Keep Cincinnati Beautiful and the Great American Cleanup, the Corryville Community Council and Corryville Recreation Center youth and teens would like to co-host a Corryville Cleanup Day event on Saturday, April 26th. The community believes a clean neighborhood is indicative of a neighborhood that cares, and is aware a clean community is thought to reduce crime and other less desirable activities. It is hoped that participation in the event will invoke a sense of community pride.

B- How will this be accomplished?

Prior to the event coordinators will recruit teams of volunteers, each with a designated leader, and assign appropriate neighborhood zones. Volunteers with pickup trucks will also be recruited. Fliers announcing the event will be distributed door-to-door throughout the neighborhood. Coordinators will obtain free gloves, garbage bags, and other supplies from the city.

On April 26th at 9 am, volunteers will assemble at the Corryville Recreation Center (2823 Eden Ave) to be supplied with event t-shirts, gloves, and garbage bags. The teams of volunteers will then fan throughout the neighborhood to their designated zones, and begin bagging litter and hauling large abandoned items to the curb. Volunteers with pick-up trucks will circle the neighborhood collecting the bagged litter and curbed items to haul to the Recreation Center for removal. The event will wrap up about noon with a pizza party at the Recreation Center.

C- Intended Results (Success Criteria)

Corryville has had a great deal of success with this event in the past. We are hoping to increase community participation, and that the event will be an opportunity for the neighborhood to come together to emphasize the need for the entire community to be more consistently diligent about eliminating litter and unsightly blight all year long. We are hoping to improve the neighborhoods appearance, instill community pride, and build community spirit.
