

2008 Project # 1 – Youth and Teen Employment Program

A- What do you want to accomplish?

In order to provide neighborhood youth and teens the experience of being responsible for a job well done, and the satisfaction of earning money, the Corryville Recreation Center would like to sponsor a Youth and Teen Employment Program. The youth and teens involved will be participants in the Center's programs, and will be mentored and supervised by trained staff from the Recreation Center.

B- How will this be accomplished?

The participating youth and teens will be selected by the Recreation Center staff. The program will run all year long, though will be primarily concentrated from mid-June through August. Jobs performed will be of benefit to the entire community, such as:

- maintenance of the neighborhood's appearance by cleaning litter, weeding, or planting areas in need of attention,
- door-to-door flier distribution for the Corryville Community Council,
- service in a volunteer zone on Corryville Cleanup Day.

Youth and teen work hours will be recorded by staff. By agreement between youth and staff prior to the performed duty, individuals will be paid directly for their hours of service or use their earnings to pay for Recreation Center field trips and outings.

C- Intended Results (Success Criteria)

We intend to provide meaningful activities for neighborhood youth and teens that are both enriching and rewarding. At the same time we intend to benefit the community with improved beautification and communication.
