

2010 CORRYVILLE SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

The Corryville Community Council proudly announces criteria for the 2010 Corryville Scholarship Program funded by the Jacobs Family Partnership Fund. These scholarships are intended to assist deserving Corryville youth by funding their participation in summer enrichment programs. Full or partial scholarships will be awarded to youth who have demonstrated commendable character, citizenship, and the potential to perform well. All awards will be made directly to the programs.

Who is Eligible ?

- ✓ **There is a Corryville residency requirement.** Applicants must have lived within the perimeter of the Corryville boundaries, as described in the attached map, for a minimum of one year.
- ✓ **Applicants must be age 18 or younger.**
- ✓ **Financial need may be a consideration.** We are interested in assisting those youth who might otherwise not be able to afford to participate.

How Do I Apply ?

To be considered a candidate for this scholarship, submit the following:

- ✓ **Completed Application**
- ✓ **A Minimum of One Letter of Recommendation**
- ✓ **Essay** (For youth in grades K-6, please see qualifier on application form.)

Following the Selection Committee's initial review of applications, candidates and their parent or guardian may be invited for a personal interview. If necessary, we may also ask confirmation of the following information from the applicant's School Administration.

- * Proof of Corryville Residence,
- * Financial Need Documentation: Eligibility for Free or Reduced-Price Meals.

Application Deadline

Please check the registration and payment schedules for your selected program carefully as they vary greatly among the programs. Submit your scholarship application as soon as possible for priority consideration. The Selection Committee would appreciate a minimum of ten days for consideration, but in any case **submissions must be postmarked by May 15th, 2010 in order for an applicant to receive consideration by the Selection Committee.** Email submissions will NOT be accepted.
